

Common Causes of Retained Primitive Reflexes

- Poor maternal nutrition

<u>Pregnancy</u>

- Mothers emotional stress
- Domestic violence
- Maternal use of drugs, alcohol, smoking
- Mothers extended periods of bed rest
- Medication
- Maternal depression
- Limited foetal movement
- Caesaren birth

During birth:

- Forceps
- Very long, slow delivery
- Very fast second part of delivery
- Foetal distress
- Epidural
- Umbilical strangulation
- Limited interaction
- Low birth weight
- Limited floor time
- Limited tummy time
- Limited nurturing touch
- Premature

- After birth: - Stress
- Exposure to domestic violence
- Limited movement
- Swaddled for long periods Long periods in equipment
 - (e.g) prams, car seats,
 - bumbo seats, walkers
